

*Galatians who in following the teachings of the Judaizers, catered to the desires of the evil nature. All false systems of religion are so adjusted that they appeal to the fallen nature of man, satisfying his religious instinct for worship, while at the same time allowing him to go on in his sin.” 24*

I have been warning the MJM in similar fashion all along in this commentary. The Legalizers in Sha'ul's day and today teach Messianic believers to keep Torah. If they try to keep Torah and find they come up short, they are told to try harder! This false system of religion forces Messianic believers to try in the flesh which is appealing to the sin nature. This brings about a false sense of spiritual security and even causes more sin. Each believer then is walking in the flesh rather than living in the Ruach. Ultimately, God brings about a spiritual crash of corruption and destruction so that there can be repentance.

Those who sow to the Ruach shall reap great blessings and rewards. The obvious connection here is to Gal. 5:19-25. If one sows to the flesh, then one's deeds will be fleshly and one will not only lose potential rewards in the Kingdom but reap judgment and corruption (verses 19-21, 6:8). If one sows to the Ruach, one's character traits will reflect the fruit of the Ruach (verses 22-25), one's deeds will be Godly and the eternal blessings will flow.

**6:9** It is an easy thing to lose heart and become weary while ministering in the MJM. So many Messianic believers are deceived in their ignorance of their personal walk with the Lord when they try to keep Torah for Torah's sake. They truly do not recognize that what they are saying and doing is contrary to
